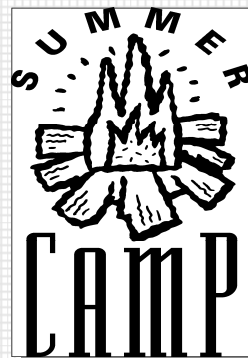
Read a Relay Good Book



The Relay For Life team has started a book store in the Cloister House. It will only be open on Sundays after the church services. The way it works is we are

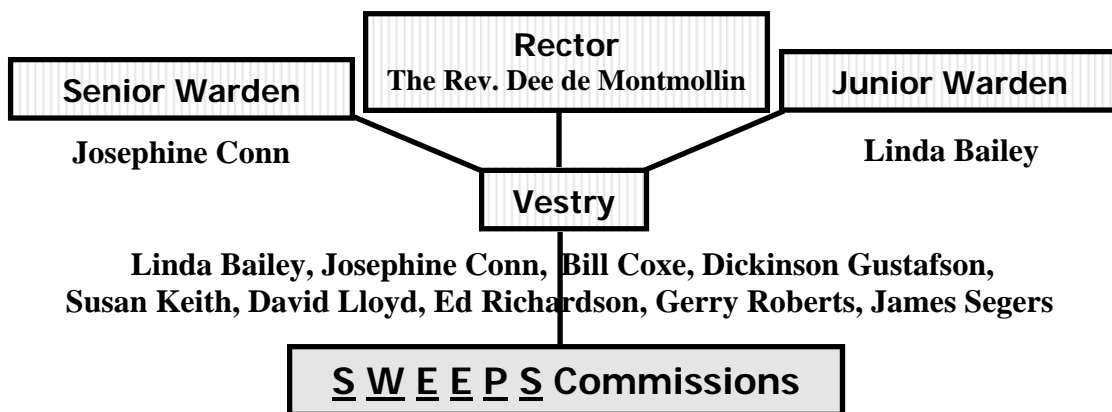

11. The meeting closed with The Lord's Prayer.

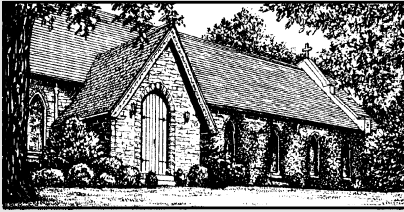
VESTRY HIGHLIGHTS
